

Authorization for Non-Prescription Over the Counter Medications

The following: **sunscreen, moisturizing skin lotion, lip balm, insect repellent, sanitizer and diaper cream** can have a single parental/guardian authorization (written approval) and can be administered without a medication consent form as long as they are non-prescription (over the counter). YMCA staff require the product to be in its original packaging, or we will not be able to apply it to your child. Please note, YMCA Educators will not track and document the administration of the following items.

- The YMCA will only administer non-prescription, over the counter medications and creams in their original packaging.
- The product must be provided by the parent/guardian.
